What is GRAICCHS Integrated Team Care Support Service?

Nhulundu is an Aboriginal Alliance that helps Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who have a chronic disease (like breathing & heart problems, diabetes, cancer etc). We work with your Doctor, as part of your Care Plan, to ensure you can get the appointments and services you need.

How do I get the Support?

You must visit your Doctor, who will make a Care Plan and send a request (referral) to the Nhulundu Health Support Services Team. They will contact you and help you to organise what the Doctor has requested. For example:

- **Health appointments** - including in city areas
- **Some travel** - if Patient Travel from Hospital Service cannot help or taxi voucher when away from home
- **Equipment** eg - Blood Sugar/monitoring machine & breathing equipment
- **Some aids are available** - for hire like walkers and shower chairs etc

Is there a Cost?

No - if your Doctor sends us a request telling us what you need, and we have enough funds, we provide this at no cost to you.
