Find the care you need

Do you need help finding and accessing Aged Care services? If so, you are not alone. The Aged Care system can be confusing and overwhelming for many people. That's why we're here to help you every step of the way. Our Care Finders are friendly and knowledgeable professionals who work with local organisations in our community.

They can help you understand your options and connect you with services that suit your needs. Whether you need help at home, in a residential facility, or somewhere else, our Care Finders are always here to lend a hand. Care Finder is designed to improve your quality of life and well-being by ensuring that you have access to the care you need.

Who is the program for?

The Care Finder program is here for older Australians who are eligible for Aged Care services and have one or more reasons for requiring intensive support to:

- Interact with My Aged Care
- Access aged care services
- Access other relevant supports in community

This includes people who are, or are not yet, receiving Aged Care services or other relevant supports. Care Finders support people who don't have family, friends, a carer or a representative they are comfortable receiving help from and who is willing and able to help them access Aged Care services and supports.

Helping you understand your Aged Care options and connect you with suitable local service providers

What assistance can we provide to our clients?

Our Care Finders are local experts who provide specialist assistance to older Australians in understanding and accessing Aged Care.

They aim to empower clients to make informed choices about their care and support them throughout their journey. Some of the ways Care Finders can help include:

- Providing information about Aged Care supports and services in their area
- Helping clients register with My Aged Care and complete screening
- Assisting clients to choose a suitable service provider and accept a service offer

- Supporting clients to prepare for assessments
- Providing support while clients are waiting for an assessment or other services to commence

Care Finders can also help clients connect with other relevant supports in the community, such as:

- Health
- Legal services
- Housing
- Social

Care Finders do not provide advocacy or care coordination, but can refer clients to other services that can help them with these needs.
