How can we help?

Nhulundu Health Service has been delivering cost-effective aged care services for 20 years. Our experienced and professional team assist the elderly and/or those living with disability in the Gladstone Region to live independently in their own home. We will work with you, your family and/or carer to develop a personalised care plan tailored to your needs and lifestyle goals.

Assistance is also available for frail older people or prematurely aged people on a low income who are experiencing difficulties accessing secure and affordable housing, care services and other related agencies.

How much does it cost?

The Australian Government subsidises a range of services, however you may be asked to make a contribution based on your financial circumstances. Your individual funding package will determine how much you will need to pay. Fees and eligibility for subsidy will be discussed with you before the relevant service commences.

Our Aged Care Programs include service delivery options for aged people or those living with disability, or their carers.

Care Finder Specialist assistance to older Australians in understanding and accessing Aged Care services.

Commonwealth Home Support Program

This service provides assistance with daily tasks for people living independently in their own home.

- Personal care
- Transport
- Shopping
- Social support

Support at Home Program Providing comprehensive support and assistance to people who live independently in their own home.

Community Transport Program Helping clients maintain their independence by providing access to their community for activities including shopping, access to various medical and specialists' services, essential services, or access to work.

Elder Care Support Specialist assistance for eligible Elders to navigate the aged care system through advocacy, referrals and assisting with access to Aged Care Services.

Assistance with Care and Housing Advocacy, referrals and assistance with paperwork for eligible older people to access and find suitable accommodation. This can include case management and connection to other services.

Hoarding and Squalor Decluttering, deep clean and improved hygiene for eligible older people to manage situations of hoarding and squalor. This can include disposal and rubbish removal along with connections to other support services.
